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##### BURGUNDY

4	MÂCON-UCHIZY, Paul Talmard 2008 <i>Unoaked white burgundy from 100% Chardonnay. Medium bodied, the richness balanced with good acidity and flavours of apple and butterscotch. Terrific value!</i>	£24	
5	CHABLIS, Daniel Dampé 2007 <i>One of France's most original wines; 100% Chardonnay but the soil imparts a steeliness to the palate and there is a hint of spring flowers on the nose.</i>	£28	
6	BOURGOGNE ALIGOTÉ, Ghislaine et Jean Hugues Goisot 2007 <i>This handsome wine is from the extreme north, near Auxerre. Stony, full of lime rind with a light zippy finish. If you love bright wine, this is right up your alley!</i>	£28	
7	POUILLY-FUISSÉ, Domaine Soufrandise 2007 <i>Southern Burgundy at its best. Full bodied fruit with butterscotch and apples intertwined and a richness which is an ideal with fuller dishes.</i>	£40	
8	CHABLIS 1ER CRU Côte de Léchet, Daniel Etienne Defaix 2001	£45	

*Daniel Defaix makes delicious Chablis that he only releases when fully mature. He eschews wood, instead keeping the wine in stainless steel, stirring up the lees to get complex biscuity flavours, combined here with soft richness.*

- 9 CHASSAGNE-MONTRACHET 1ER CRU Morgeot, Henri Germain 2005 £55  
*Lovely pineapple and lime fruit, this wine is very pure with the attractive, mineral terroir character that is typical of Chassagne. The Germaines are based in Meursault, their Chassagne vines being inherited by Madame Germain.*
- 10 PULIGNY-MONTRACHET Folatières Premiere Cru , Paul Pernot 2005 £85  
*This is deep and complex with aromas of white flowers, hazelnuts, almonds and peaches. Simply outstanding wine!*
- 11 CRIOTS-BÂTARD-MONTRACHET Grand Cru, Nicolas Potel 2005 £95  
*Criots is an intriguing little vineyard set slightly lower than Bâtard as you take the back road to Chassagne- Montrachet. Creamy sweet fruit, some apple and white currants. It is extremely fine with wonderful length.*
- 12 MONTRACHET, Louis Jadot 2003 £340  
*Jadot's Montrachet explodes from the glass with boisterous aromas of ripe pears and spiced apples. A bold, rich, medium to full-bodied effort, it reveals great concentration, depth of fruit, density, and length. Its almost chewy character is filled with white fruits, mineral, buttered toast, and spice. Truly world class wine!*

#### LANGUEDOC & SOUTH WEST

- 13 BERGERAC, Chateau Tour des Gendres 2009 £20  
*A blend of Semillon and Sauvignon with produced from organic grapes. Rich tropical fruit, fairly full bodied,idea with fuller flavoured dishes.*
- 14 SAVENNIÈRES ROCHE AUX MOINES, Domaine Aux Moines 2005 £34  
*Chenin Blanc from the Loire grown on schist soil. This is full bodied with a dry richness and hints of Quince on the palate. Roche aux Moines is one of the two superior vineyards of the appellation.*

#### LOIRE

- 15 MUSCADET SÈVRE ET MAINE, Sur Lie, Les Gras Moutons, Domaine La Haute Fevrie 2006 £25  
*Rich deep and complex Muscadet from a single vineyard. Full bodied, crisp and mineral, the ideal partner for shellfish. Unfashionable but we still love good Muscadet!*
- 16 POUILLY FUME, Les Croqloups/Domaine Chauveau 2008 £31  
*100% Sauvignon Blanc from eastern Loire. Crisp, slightly chalky flavour, good body. Excellent partner to river fish and salads.*
- 17 SANCERRE, André Dezat et Fils 2008 £30  
*Dry, fruity with a wonderfully delicate bouquet and great length. This is a first class Sancerre!*
- 18 BORDEAUX GRAND VIN SEC, Château Doisy-Daëne, Dubourdieu 2007 £36  
*The home of Denis Dubourdieu who pioneered modern-style, dry Graves. This has elegant fruit with a hint of oak. Consistently good.*
- 19 MANSENG/PETIT COURBU, Jurançon Sec, Domaine de Souch 2006 £47

*This biodynamic pale silver green wine displays exotic fruit aromas, floral notes and great freshness on the nose. On the palate the electric minerality and the richness are extremely well balanced. Ideal aperitif or served with shellfish.*

## **RHONE**

- 20      CONDRIEU Côteau de Chéry, André Perret 2007      £52  
*Very complex with a barrage of aromas and flavours: peaches, apricots, apples, pears and a hint of honey all put in an appearance. Drink now, or wait 10 years after vintage.*
- 21      CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE BLANC, Château de Beaucastel, P Perrin 2007      £75  
*A delicious dry white wine with lovely floral, acacia notes on the nose and also the palate. Elegant, rich, dense with fresh honey, lime, toast and spice. Super!*

## **Italy**

- 22      ORGANIC PINOT GRIGIO - Touchstone 2008      £19  
*The tropical fruit character of Italian Pinot Grigio is perfectly captured. A stunning organic wine continues to impress our guests!*
- 23      VERNACCIA DI SAN GIMIGNANO, Falchini 2008      £23  
*The Vernaccia grape is native to the area around the Tuscan town of San Gimignano. Medium bodied and dry with a smooth lanolin texture.*
- 24      Ca Adua, Fontanassa GAVI 2007      £27  
*Full bodied wine made from Cortese grape. Fontanassa shows more body and complexity than most examples of this wine. Definitely Gavi with attitude!*
- 25      FIANO DI AVELLINO DOCG, Terre di Dora, Terredora 2008      £35  
*From one of the best white DOCG areas in Italy and a great producer, whose vines used to supply the famous Mastroberardino label, this has wonderful natural smokiness, masses of spice, hazelnuts and apple freshness too.*

## **Austria**

- 26      GRÜNER-VELTLINER, Willi Bründlmayer 2008      £28  
*After France, Austria is probably producing the best dry white wines in the world. The Gruner is indigenous to Austria and is noted for rich dry wines with a hint of white pepper. Brundlmayer is one of the leading producers and is biodynamic.*

## **Germany**

- 27      Erdener Treppchen RIESLING KABINETT, Weingut Meulenhof 2007      £20  
*Soft, creamy Kabinett with easy-going fruit from a wonderful vineyard on the Mosel river. Traditionally made in large oak 'fuder'.*

## **Spain**

- 28      Fillaboia Albariño, Rias Baixas 2007      £37  
*This is a slightly complex wine, with flavours of just-ripe bananas, mango and some tasty blanched almond and a touch of sea brine. A well balanced and intriguing wine that continues to impress our guests!*

## **USA**

- 29      Cuvaison CHARDONNAY, Carneros 2007      £40

*Very much in the Burgundy tradition, even the winery's name is French! The fruit for this wine is sourced from the cool climate of Carneros to the south of the region. Dry, intense with buttery, nutty aromas and tropical fruit.*

- 30 Bethel Heights CHARDONNAY, Oregon 2007 £34  
*This estate vineyard produces fantastic wine. Lush Anjou pear, peach and apple flavours with a toasted hazelnut background. Aromas of cinnamon, vanilla spice, Asian pears, and green apple. Mmmm!*
- 31 Duck Pond Cellars PINOT GRIS, Oregon 2007 £34  
*Enticing nose of peach, vanilla, and lime with an opulent, rich palate. Excellent with a wide range of foods.*

### **New Zealand**

- 32 Mud House SAUVIGNON BLANC, Marlborough 2009 £22  
*This elegant wine is dry, crisp with a lovely passion fruit and guava character, backed up by gooseberry herb flavours. Mouth-watering finish!*
- 33 Forest Estate GEWURZTRAMINER, Marlborough 2006 £26  
*Quintessential Marlborough abounds with lychee, spice and rose petal aromas, soft full textural palate and a touch of fruit sweetness.*
- 34 Kumeu River PINOT GRIS, Auckland 2008 £27  
*This extraordinary grape variety is turning heads. Full of floral aromas it is best described as a 'half way house' between Alsace Pinot Gris and a top notch Pinot Grigio.*
- 35 Richmond Plains ORGANIC BLANC DE NOIR, Nelson 2008 £35  
*Pink diamond colour award winning organic white wine is 100% Pinot Noir. Aromatic with lime blossom, pear and biscuit characters. Full and fruity with attractive pear, baked apple, peaches and nectarine flavours and an exotic spicy finish. Try it and be hooked!*

### **Australia**

- 36 Wakefield CHARDONNAY, Clare Valley 2008 £21  
*Rich buttery chardonnay with a little oak ageing adds to the complexity.*
- 37 Farr VIOGNIER, Geelong 2005 £48  
*Winemaker Gary Farr has a small but perfectly formed estate at Bannockburn near Geelong. Unmistakable Viognier fruit with gorgeous peach and apricot aromas, and a voluptuous palate. Mineral-laden, spicy, honeyed and powerful. Very, very good!*

### **South Africa**

- 38 Wide River CHENIN BLANC, Robertson 2009 £18  
*This delicate wine has lovely ripe fruit flavours with hints of melon and pears, fresh floral aromas and a delightful off-dry finish.*

### **Argentina**

- 39 Black River SEMILLON Patagonia 2008 £16  
*The Canale Family vineyards has ideal growing conditions, so good that the vineyards are naturally organic. Nicely zesty, and lemony fruit, with herbal notes.*
- 40 Finca Las Moras VIOGNIER 2008 £19  
*Flowers and fruit, orange blossom and ripe apricot with a hint of pineapple and peaches. Full-bodied, refreshing.*

48	Château Ballan-Larquette AC BORDEAUX 2004 Extraordinarily high percentage of Cabernet Sauvignon accounts for its elegant and refined palate and fine grained tannins. A seriously good value Claret.	£22
49	Château Mondesir-Gazin, CÔTES DE BLAYE 2004 A full bodied style of claret, high in Merlot with a significant percentage of Malbec.	£30
50	Château Trois Chardrons, MARGAUX 2004 <i>This wine is produced from a small parcel of the renowned estate of Chateau Palmer. Elegant and refined with the distinctive blackberry flavour of Margaux.</i>	£49
51	Château Pipeau, GRAND CRU SAINT-EMILION 2006 <i>This is a property that has attracted considerable favourable coverage recently for its powerful, full wines. There is a large amount of new oak used but this supports and complements the concentrated fruit. Big, rich and long.</i>	£40
52	Château Duluc de Branaire Ducru, SAINT-JULIEN 2005	£45

*An appealing nose, aromatic with hints of pepper and blackberry fruit. Good body and really well judged balance. This is the second wine of Château Branaire-Ducru.*

- 53 Château Grand-Puy-Lacoste, 5ME CRU PAUILLAC 1988 £90  
*Initially a fairly solid, sturdy vintage, the wines are now showing plenty of attractive, ripe fruit. This is classic Pauillac, with good structure and blackcurrant fruit from a very consistent property managed by François-Xavier Borie.*
- 54 Château Latour, 1ER CRU PAUILLAC 1991 £290  
*This Bordeaux was rated the best in the region in 1991 and is world class. The ripe, muscular, beefy wine offers a dense, dark ruby color, and a reticent bouquet of black-cherries, cassis, minerals, roasted nuts, spices, and subtle herbs. Medium-bodied, with excellent richness, fine glycerin, and aggressive tannin.*

## **BURGUNDY**

- 55 Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Vincent Morey 2007 £29  
*A good introduction to red burgundy. Crisp pinot noir fruit with hints of cherries.*
- 56 Beaune Vieilles Vignes, Domaine des clos 2000 £45  
*Very stylish, good value Burgundy from old vines. Very fine medium bodied palate which shows lively flavours of strawberry and red cherries, with a floral bouquet.*
- 57 VOLNAY 1ER CRU Champans, Domaine de Montille 2004 £60  
*Beautifully perfumed, this has aromas of violets, followed by black cherry fruits on the palate and a structure that allows it to last. Champans is a mid-slope 1er cru, often producing some of the most balanced wines in the village.*
- 58 NUITS-SAINT-GEORGES 1ER CRU Les Vaucrains, Henri Gouges 2004 £65  
*Vaucrains is an upper slope vineyard with thin soils, consequently giving a concentrated wine in the typically structured style of this part*
- 59 GRANDS ÉCHÉZAUX, Grands Freres 1987 £130  
*Fully mature grand cru Burgundy. Gamey fruit shows ripe black fruits and upon opening reveals exotic spices and candied orange peel.*
- 60 RICHEBOURG grand cru, Domaine du Clos Frantin ??? £240  
*Medium cherry red Grand Cru Burgundy. It has aromas of smoke, perfume, strawberry, blossom (rose, peony), plus sweet spices. The body is suave and very harmonious, with good length and fine new oak. An elegant thoroughbred!*

## **BEAUJOLAIS**

- 61 FLEURIE, Clos de la Roilette, Coudert Père & Fils 2007 £29  
*100% Gamay grape from the Beaujolais. Medium bodied and very grapey.*

## **RHONE**

- 62 CÔTES-DU-RHÔNE, Domaine de la Mordorée 2007 £27  
*Mordoree use a blend of five grapes to produce this full bodied and lush rhone wine. Spicy notes and lashings of black fruit give the wine class beyond its station.*
- 63 CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, Domaine du Vieux Télégraphe, H Brunier et Fils 1998 £60  
*One of the best wines in this area, Vieux Télégraphe has a black cherry and mulberry nose, good solid fruit and well balanced tannins.*
- 64 GIGONDAS, Domaine des Espiers 2007 £39  
*From a village close to Chateauneuf du Pape, this is a lookalike with dry elegant fruit hinting of woodfires, herbs and spices.*

65 HERMITAGE, Monier de la Sizeranne, M Chapoutier 2006 £70  
*A deep garnet colour with purple tinges, the nose is of red fruits, raspberries, blackcurrants, with a hint of licorice and a touch of tar. Concentrated, elegant and well balanced.*

#### **LOIRE**

66 CHINON, Bernard Baudry 2007 £28  
*From the middle Loire and produced from the Cabernet franc grape. This full bodied dry wine is redolent of black olives and herbs. Baudry is the leading producer.*

67 PINEAU D'AUNIS, Domaine Belliviere 2005 £30  
*Eric Nicolas is one of the great producers of France and is currently in progress to make his vineyards biodynamic. The pinot D'auis grape is indigenous to the Loire.*

#### **LANGUEDOC & SOUTH WEST**

68 COTEAUX DU LANGUEDOC, Domaine Henry 2006 £22  
*Francois Henry makes Languedoc wines like no other. Ruby red, sumptuous with velvety palate.*

69 Gaillac, Domaine Rotier 2007 £27  
*The SW of France uses grape varieties seldom found elsewhere. Here is a blend of Duras and Braucoul with just a touch of Syrah. Dry, full bodied, good partner for robust dishes.*

70 Domaine de la Tour du Bon - BANDOL- France 2005 £44  
*Dive into the wild black yonder with this outstanding Bandol. A taste makes one feel as if they were in some funky dive of a bar on the quai in Bandol, smoking cigarettes, and draining a carafe. Another carafe, please, and pass those olives!*

#### **Italy**

71 MONTEPULCIANO D'ABRUZZO, Taverna Nova 2007 £18  
*From the 'Montepulciano' grape, enjoy the warm, spicy cherry fruit in this robust, earthy wine with rich red meat dishes.*

72 CHIANTI, Fattoria Montellori 2007 £31  
*The Montellori Chianti captures all that is beautiful in Montalbano Chianti. It offers up soft, delicate textured fruit of dark cherries and currants. Palpable clay minerals come out on the finish giving this a solid backbone. Deliciously authentic Chianti!*

73 DOCETTO, Einaudi 2007 £30  
*Most dolcetto is light and fruity, but his beauty from Einaudi is full bodied, rich with just the correct amount of acidity to refresh the palate.*

74 BAROLO Marcarini 2003 £55  
*Traditional Barolo, the Nebbiolo grape gives this wine a perfumed, mature, sweet, wood-spicy fruit aromas, intertwined with more complex notes of game, leather and violets.*

75 BRUNELLO DI MONTALCINO DOCG, Colleoni, Santa Maria 2002 £55  
*Made following organic guidelines by Marino and Luisa Colleoni from spectacular vineyards near Montalcino this has great finesse and fantastic length of rich plum and cherry flavours. Its weight and depth are also to be savoured.*

76 BAROLO DOCG, Ginestra, Paolo Conterno 2005 £70

*A concentrated wine which comes from the Ginestra vineyard, one of the best crus of the Barolo area. Twenty year-old vines give extra complexity and a density of black fruits, liquorice and typical tar flavours. A superb wine!*

- 77 BOLGHERI SASSICAIA DOC, Tenuta San Guido 1994 £170  
*Wonderful ripe fruit - currant, blackberries, a little plum. Notes of sweet chocolate and hints of smoke and spice. Wood is present, but subtle and well-integrated. Soft and silky on the palate with fine and velvety tannins. A classy, impeccably balanced wine!*

### **Spain**

- 78 RIOJA Viña Arana Reserva 2001 £38  
*Two years in oak casks deliver spicy aromas and flavours. A bright silky ruby red to excite the Rioja aficionado!*
- 79 Pirita, Almaroja 2007 £39  
*Made by Englishwoman Charlotte Allen, from a region close to the Portuguese border, this wine is spicy with lovely crunchy fruit. The main grape is the indigenous Juan Garcia.*
- 80 VEGA SICILIA VALBUENA, Ribera del Duero 2003 £110  
*The second wine of the famous Vega Sicilia estate, the first in Spain to introduce French vine varieties. Mainly Tempranillo and only released after over four years, it is deep dark and rich, with great elegance and length.*

### **Argentina**

- 81 MALBEC, Finca Las Moras 2008 £18  
*A desert climate produces a soft, medium to full bodied wine with a ripe red fruit flavour and an elegant touch of smoke and vanilla.*

### **New Zealand**

- 82 Roaring Meg PINOT NOIR, Mt. Difficulty 2008 £34  
*Central Otago in South Island is the buzz area for Pinot Noir and Mount Difficulty's Roaring Meg delivers full bodied Pinot fruit in spades.*
- 83 CJ Pask CABERNET/MERLOT/MALBEC Hawkes Bay 2006 £23  
*Internationally recognised for mineral-rich, elegant and classical Bordeaux blends. This wine offers high levels of complex, spicy and long-lasting mulberry and blackcurrant fruit, wrapped in fine, supple tannins this is very complete and wonderful value.*

### **Australia**

- 84 Bird in the Hand SHIRAZ, Mount Lofty Ranges 2007 £23  
*Limited release wine aged in French oak. Subtle intensity with aromas and flavours of dark red berries and spice. Fab!*
- 85 Devil's Corner PINOT NOIR, Tamar Ridge 2008 £25  
*Tasmania's cool climate is ideal for Pinot Noir. This ruby light bodied wine delivers restrained wild-cherry aroma and tart red fruit flavours. Look out for the earthy red-clay nuance which develops in the glass. Much more than a New World Pinot!*
- 86 Simon Hackett OLD VINE GRENACHE, McLaren Vale 2007 £27

*This old vine delivers a deep purple coloured, easy drinking red wine with a blackcurrant nose. Rich berry flavours and surprising hints of liquorice and mint. A Grove favourite!*

- 87 Hamelin Bay 'Five Ashes' CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Margaret River £34  
*The Margaret River is known for its stylish Cabernets. This wine is highly polished and carries its rich fruit very well. The tannins are are rich and well balanced and there is enough plummy fruit to give the palate a subtle richness.*

### **Chile**

- 88 Rayun CARMENERE, 2008 £19  
*An intense violet color in the glass with touches of spice and tar on the nose. The mouth is rich, with deep black/red fruits and earthy notes of incense and tobacco. If you've never experienced Carménère, this is the place to start!*

### **South Africa**

- 89 Paul Cluver PINOT NOIR, Elgin 2008 £23  
*Lightly oaked and light, rather akin to a Côte de Beaune. This has a pale ruby and brick colour, intense cherry fruit, with a little smoky oak and a great freshness which typifies the elegant, cool-climate wines coming out of the popular Elgin region.*
- 90 Kaapzicht PINOTAGE, Stellenbosch 2006 £24  
Gorgeously soft, rich Pinotage from Stellenbosch that is packed with mulberry fruit and cedar wood nuances. A fabulous Pinotage!
- 91 Max, Miles Messop CABERNET SAUVIGNON/ MERLOT/ PETIT VERDOT – Stellenbosch 2004 £48  
*Meaty and gamey nose, showing attractive plum fruit. A classy wine perfect accompaniment with our game and red meat dishes. Simply fantastic wine!*
- 92 Galpin Peak PINOT NOIR, Walker Bay, Bouchard-Finlayson 2007 £35  
*Strong Burgundian influence to this estate's flagship wine, has much in common with a rich Côte de Nuits. Impressively concentrated on both nose and palate, this has a host of sweet blue fruit, balanced by hints of nettle and racy, bitter cherry. Expansive and velvete in terms of texture, with great power and length.*

### **Lebanon**

- 93 CHÂTEAU MUSAR, Bekaa Valley, Gaston Hochar 2002 £35  
*Legendary Lebanese estate founded in 1930. Very ripe fruit, with spice and leather. Unique and one of Neil's favourites!*

### **USA**

- 94 Ridge Lytton Springs, California 2005 £50  
*A very stylish wine based on Zinfandel with a touch of Petite Sirah and Carignane. Packed full of delicious briary and boysenberry fruit backed up by a firm but not dominant structure.*
- 95 Shafer Vineyards 'One Point Five' Cabernet Sauvignon, Stag's Leap 2006 £95  
*This is an elegant and silky wine with dense, rich, blackcurrant and plum fruit intertwined with chocolate, vanilla and cedar flavours. Very approachable when young and for a decade after the vintage.*
